SUMMARY OF PARISH REVIEW – Mosgiel North Taieri

Over the past three months, a Review Team appointed by the Southern Presbytery (Michelle Dean, Brendon McRae, Anne Thomson) has conducted a review of the Mosgiel North Taieri parish on behalf of the Southern Presbytery. The full report is available for anyone who would like to receive it – please I contact the church office if you want a copy.

A summary of the Review findings:

Strengths:

Growth in teams sharing in ministry – worship, outreach to children and families, pastoral care

Commitment of a number of key people in various areas of church life Connections with families through Whānau Fun

Commitment to maintaining buildings and making them available to the community

Growing partnership with East Taieri through SHFT

Challenges:

Demographics – the current age of the congregation indicates future decline in capacity

Generational renewal – small green shoots, but time and energy required Leadership succession – Session and Managers will need new members in the future

Finances – current financial situation will only provide for halftime ministry Worship services – the energy and personnel required to sustain three services most Sundays

A lot of work being done by a small number of people

Opportunities

Develop mission connection with Taieri College, with North Taieri community, with hall users

Taieri Court chaplaincy and partnership with PSO

Looking at Presbyterian presence, resources, capacity, future ministry across the Taieri with East Taieri and Maungatua

Threats

Reducing energy, capability, finances, people

Change not acceptable to congregation, steady decline

Become a landlord of useful buildings rather than building relationships for the gospel

The Ministry Settlement Board (MSB) for Mosgiel North Taieri Presbyterian Parish is making good progress on a number of the important tasks required in preparation for a final report. Once completed, the report along with the recommended "Terms of Call" must be approved by Session and agreed to by the congregation. It is then sent to Southern Presbytery for approval. The MSB met on Wednesday 9th July. Discussion was held on a number of matters including Ministry Expectations, Terms of Call and the Congregational Review. The current Church Profile is currently undergoing an update and we look forward to a summary of the Congregational Review which is due for our next meeting in August. We are aiming for a draft report to be ready for approval by Session come early Spring. The MSB continues to meet monthly with the **next** meeting scheduled for Wednesday 13th August at 7 pm.
