What does it mean to be a member?

It can mean belonging to a group or a club, being involved in its activities, paying your dues, getting to know other people there.



But in the Christian church, being a member means being part of the Body of Christ, being joined to one another, even those who are very different, because we are first joined to Jesus Christ, who is the head of the body. This is the image that Paul used in 1 Corinthians 12 and in Ephesians 4.

Being a member of the body of Christ (which is the church) asks us to love one another, to care for one another, to encourage one another, to bear one another's burdens and share one another's joys.

What about here at Mosgiel/North Taieri? What does it mean to be a member here?

A member is one who has been baptised, who is professing faith in Jesus Christ and living out their faith in daily life, who is uniting in the worship, life and mission of the congregation and supporting the congregation as they are able.

We also have associate members, who wish to be associated with the worship, life and mission of the congregation, who seek to lead a life consistent with Christian faith, but who do not wish to be full members.

Members and associate members can participate in communion and vote at congregational meetings, but only members can be nominated to eldership.

Session wants to invite you, if you are not currently a member, to consider whether it is time to express your commitment to the life, worship and mission of Mosgiel/North Taieri by becoming a full member.
