Greetings to all the churches in our Southern Presbytery.

I write regarding the recent storm event that has hit many of our southern communities, particularly those in Southland and Clutha. As the clean up here in Lawrence returned us to power and water after 5 days, we still have many farmers and outlying roads and homes without power or even cell coverage. Fatigue is setting in. Hundreds of trees are down, fences damaged, water networks in disarray, and much of the rest of the world carries on with life as normal.

Can I say a huge thank you to those of you who are out in your communities, checking on others, providing centres, food, a friendly conversation, generators or other practical support. Events such as these can bring out the very best in people. After a few days of responding there will now be tired minds and bodies without much end in sight for some.

For those who face challenge and major repairs on their own properties may you know the grace and peace of Jesus as you live with the uncertainty of this event. For those who are supporting others, thank you for giving of yourselves to make a difference in a time of crisis.
