## White Ribbon Day is Thursday 25th November



Presbyterian Support Otago and the Presbyterian Church of Aotearoa New Zealand are strong supporters of the White Ribbon campaign, which opposes violence against women and family violence.

This year the theme for White Ribbon Day is 'Shining a Light on Violence Prevention' and aims to create awareness of what constitutes family violence, how to prevent violence, and how to safely intervene to assist those experiencing violence. We will gather together to tie white ribbons on our fences at our churches following our morning services at North Taieri and at Mosgiel and our 2pm service at Mosgiel next Sunday, 28th November, praying for victims of domestic violence as we do so.
