At this one day meeting on Thursday (with opening worship on Wednesday evening) held online, commissioners to GA '21 dealt with urgent and procedural matters only, leaving more substantial discussion and decisions until the physically present meeting, planned for April next year, can be safely held. Voting for the Moderator Designate took place, resulting in the election of Rev. Rose Luxford, minister at St. Paul's, Oamaru, to take on the mantle of leadership following the two years' leadership of Right Rev. Hamish Galloway, of Christchurch. Our Session, along with many others, nominated Rose for this position
